New Birkenhead Substation boosts Electricity Supply for growing region

Amid grey skies and a light winter drizzle, Overstrand Executive Mayor, Archie Klaas, officially cut the ribbon at the ceremonial opening of the Birkenhead Substation on Thursday, 26 June 2025.

True to his reputation for giving credit where it's due, Mayor Klaas praised the team behind the R75 million project under the leadership of Director of Infrastructure Services, Stephen Müller, and the dedicated support of municipal officials and contractors. Although former Gansbaai Electrical Department Senior Manager, Danie Maree, was unable to attend the event due to ill health, he too was recognised for his significant role in the early stages of the project.

The Birkenhead 66/11kV substation is the largest electrical project ever undertaken by Overstrand Municipality. Situated just outside Gansbaai on the road to the Danger Point Lighthouse, the new substation will ease the burden on

the existing network and ensure sufficient supply to support the region's rapidly growing future development. The substation project has been in the pipeline for over a decade. It was first proposed in the 2011 Overstrand Electricity Masterplan, and a 2019

load growth investigation report confirmed the need for a second supply point to meet rising demand in the Greater Gansbaai area. Without this upgrade, the existing network would have been unable to handle the projected growth, potentially leading to costly and extensive infrastructure improvements.

Construction began in August 2022 and was completed by February 2025.



Overstrand Executive Mayor Archie Klaas officially cut the ribbon of the Birkenhead Substation. Deputy Mayor Elnora Gillion, fellow councillors, contractors, consultants and officials from the electrical department were also there to share in the celebration.

The total cost of the project amounted to R75.6 million, including a R7.1 million Eskom connection fee. Funding was provided by the Department of Mineral Resources and Energy (now the Department of Electricity and Energy) and Overstrand Municipality. The project included the installation of a 4.7km, 66kV overhead steel monopole power line from the Eskom supply point to a newly constructed 66/11kV indoor substation. The

facility houses a 20MVA transformer, switchgear, and all necessary auxiliary equipment. Provision has also been made for a second 20MVA transformer in the future.

In addition, the Birkenhead Substation offers a second Eskom supply point to the area, supplementing the existing 11kV system and significantly increasing electricity distribution capacity in Gansbaai. The higher intake voltage of 66kV will also enable the municipality to purchase electricity at a lower tariff, bringing long-term savings on its electricity account. Design work was carried

out by iX Engineers, with Lyners providing support during implementation. Adenco Construction oversaw the electrical installation and managed the overall construction process.

As part of the tender requirements, 30% of the construction value was required to be subcontracted to Qualifying Small Enterprises (QSEs) and Exempt Micro Enterprises (EMEs) registered on the Central Supplier Database. This initiative

aimed to promote skills development and the use of local labour. The requirement was met through the appointment of a range of subcontractors who provided services such as civil and building works, security, design, materials supply, labour, transport, and the testing and commissioning of equipment.

The project also included a social responsibility component, with computer equipment valued at R50 000 donated to Gansbaai Academia High School.

Curro 'Cats' and Panthera 'Cats'



Curro 'Cats'

On Tuesday, 1 July 2025, twelve learners from Curro Hermanus High School spent the day lending a helping hand at Panthera Africa Big Cat Sanctuary just outside Stanford to give them a *Fresh New Look* - what an experience for them - Curro 'Cats' and Panthera 'Cats'!

Under the guidance of their Visual Arts Teacher, Vivienne Mitchley, and with the support of teachers Ester Venter, Nadia Viljoen, and Carli Joubert-Basson, the learners - aged 13 to 15 - worked hard to give the entrance and curio area of the sanctuary a much-needed facelift. "The learners were armed with

shovels, gloves, paintbrushes, and lots of enthusiasm," said Vivienne. "The group cleared spaces, planted water-wise indigenous plants donated by the teachers and students, and gave the jungle gym a fresh coat of paint." And the results? The

once tired-looking play area is now clean and ready to welcome visiting children again.

"But their kindness didn't stop there," Vivienne said. "The learners also collected and donated cardboard boxes to help enrich the lives of the big cats." These boxes are used in special enrichment activities that keep the animals active and mentally stimulated.

To show their appreciation, Panthera Africa treated the group to a special Educational Visit, led by director Taryn Blows. She shared the

sanctuary's story and explained its mission as a rescue sanctuary that gives big cats - rescued from difficult and often heartbreaking circumstances - a safe, forever home. Panthera Africa does not breed, trade, or allow interaction with the animals, and promotes responsible tourism.

Although the Foundation Phase learners from Curro Hermanus have visited before, this was the first time the High School learners joined - and it was a memorable one! "Another Curro Cats Day is already planned for later this month, and excitement is building for Stage 2 of the project, where Jacques Venter, husband of teacher Ester Venter, will lend a hand with the curio shop upgrades," Vivienne said. She also said as the bus pulled away, the lions let out farewell roars - perhaps their way of saying thank you, Curro Cats!

"Ikamva could impact positively on our communities, by empowering them with good services which will assist them to arise above their circumstances and to contribute to the economy of South Africa," said Jolande Sauls, Manager: Ikamva. "We envisaged expanding our program to reach more youth, children and patients in the Stanford and Gansbaai area, Baardskeerdersbos, Pearly Beach and Buffeljagsbaai." As an organisation they face specific challenges in terms of reaching this goal such as own Transport, Running Costs of the Organisation, Salaries, Nutritional Support, Support and Maintenance. In addition to this the organisation has

identified a piece of land (plot) next to the current ECD center and a plot next to the rugby field which they wishes to purchase to expand on the services already provided by the ECD center.

Motivation of various projects Blompark, which form part of the greater Gansbaai area, is a disadvantaged community facing many challenges such as youth unemployment, substance abuse (both children and adults), accesses to healthcare, early childhood development facilities, etc. For the past 19 years Ikamva has

committed itself to addressing these challenges. Within this organisation four different projects is being managed under the supervision of Jolande.




